TASTING NOTES

Brilliant red in the glass. A light roasted aroma complemented by fresh berries. Savory notes of earth and black tea balanced with a rich core of black fruits. Round tannins, good acidity. A wine with a long line of praise and great value.

VINEYARDS

This wine is made mostly with old vine Monastrell grapes, which are grown at an altitude of 700 meters above sea level. The vineyard yields are low, as with the vines of Cabernet Sauvignon & Syrah, resulting in a very concentrated, complex and elegant wine.
