## TASTING NOTES

An intense purple wine exhibiting aromas of ripe cherries and plums framed with notes of cedar and spice. In the mouth it offers a great concentration with pronounced flavors of red fruit jam. The finely integrated tannins give it a long and persistent finish.

## VINEYARDS

Bodegas Morca is located in the village of Borja, in the province of Zaragoza. Grapes of Garnacha from small plots with low yields are hand-picked and fermented separately in small vats, then transferred into French oak barrels to complete the malolactic fermentation process. The wine spends 15 months of maturing and then every barrel is tasted and after a very strict selection we obtain a limited
