TASTING NOTES

"Inky ruby. Deeply perfumed aromas of ripe black and blue fruits and potpourri pick up a smoky mineral nuance and a vanilla quality with air. Palate-coating blackberry, cherry liqueur, spicecake and floral pastille flavors are complemented by suggestions of candied licorice and cracked pepper that emerge on the back half. Finishes very long and spicy, showing an appealingly sweet note, gently gripping tannins and fine definition."

VINEYARDS

The Cariñena and Garnacha vines used for the production of this wine have an approximate age ranging from 35 to 50 years. The vineyards of Garnacha are in the area of Cornudella de Montsant, around 2,000 ft in altitude, and on slate soils. The Cariñena vineyards are located in the Darmós and Masroig area and are on clay soils. The Syrah vineyards are located on limestone soils.
