## VINEYARDS

Rejón is the name of our best Tempranillo vineyard located within Toro's appellation in the town of El Pego. The 130 year old vines are planted on incredible top layer of gravel over very sandy soils. The production is very limited and the wine reflects the typicity and genuineness of the indigenous grapes coming from this unique terroir. The grapes are carefully hand-picked in small 15kg baskets, fermented in small vats and moved to 225L French oak barrels aging for 20 months.

This velvety red offers a rich mix of layered black cherry, crushed stone and smoked pepper. The tannins are dense, yet polished, providing a lovely structure and a long silky finish.
